



STATEMENT REGARDING COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)
Baseball and Softball – Spring 2020

MSMC Baseball and Softball Players, Families, and Supporters:

The primary responsibility of the MSMC Parks and Recreation is to ensure a safe environment for our community. After discussion with local government and health officials it was determined that the 2020 Spring Baseball and Softball season would put families at risk, and in good faith we could not jeopardize the health and safety of our community. The MSMC Parks and Recreation board has voted unanimously to **CANCEL** the 2020 Spring Baseball and Softball season.

REFUND: The MSMC Parks and Recreation office is currently closed to the public in order to follow the guidelines of social distancing in efforts of fighting Covid-19. Beginning on Monday, 4/27/2020, the Parks and Recreation staff have begun the process of issuing everyone a refund of fees for registration of the spring 2020 Baseball/Softball season and will be mailing the checks to the address on file. The refund process will require some time and the staff will work diligently to get the job done quickly and efficiently. This is going to be an undertaking, and we ask that you please, do not send us direct messages, Facebook messages, texts, etc. so that we can keep all the information clean and concise.

The Parks and Recreation staff and board of commissioners decided to cancel after discussion and efforts of trying to postpone in hopes of being able to proceed. We were looking to forward to an exciting season for the participants, volunteers, and spectators, however the safety of those involved is always the number one concern. An exciting season was just weeks away when this virus hit, but we will rebound and play ball again. As always, we would like to thank those who were volunteering to coach and lead by example. We would also like to thank those involved for your patience and understanding with this unprecedented time with the ever-changing situation, that is Covid-19.

We are hopeful and expect that we will be able to resume Parks and Recreation activities per the usual in the Fall with the possibilities of an extended season. However, given the fluidity of the situation, we are not able to provide a definite timeframe.
